After finishing his education, Stacpoole travelled widely, taking up a job as a ship's doctor. His time spent at sea undoubtedly inspired many stories and characters in his later writing. Stacpoole's writing career started with the publication of *The Intended* in 1894, but his most famous work is *The Blue Lagoon*, a romance novel published in 1908.
